RULES FOR SINGING

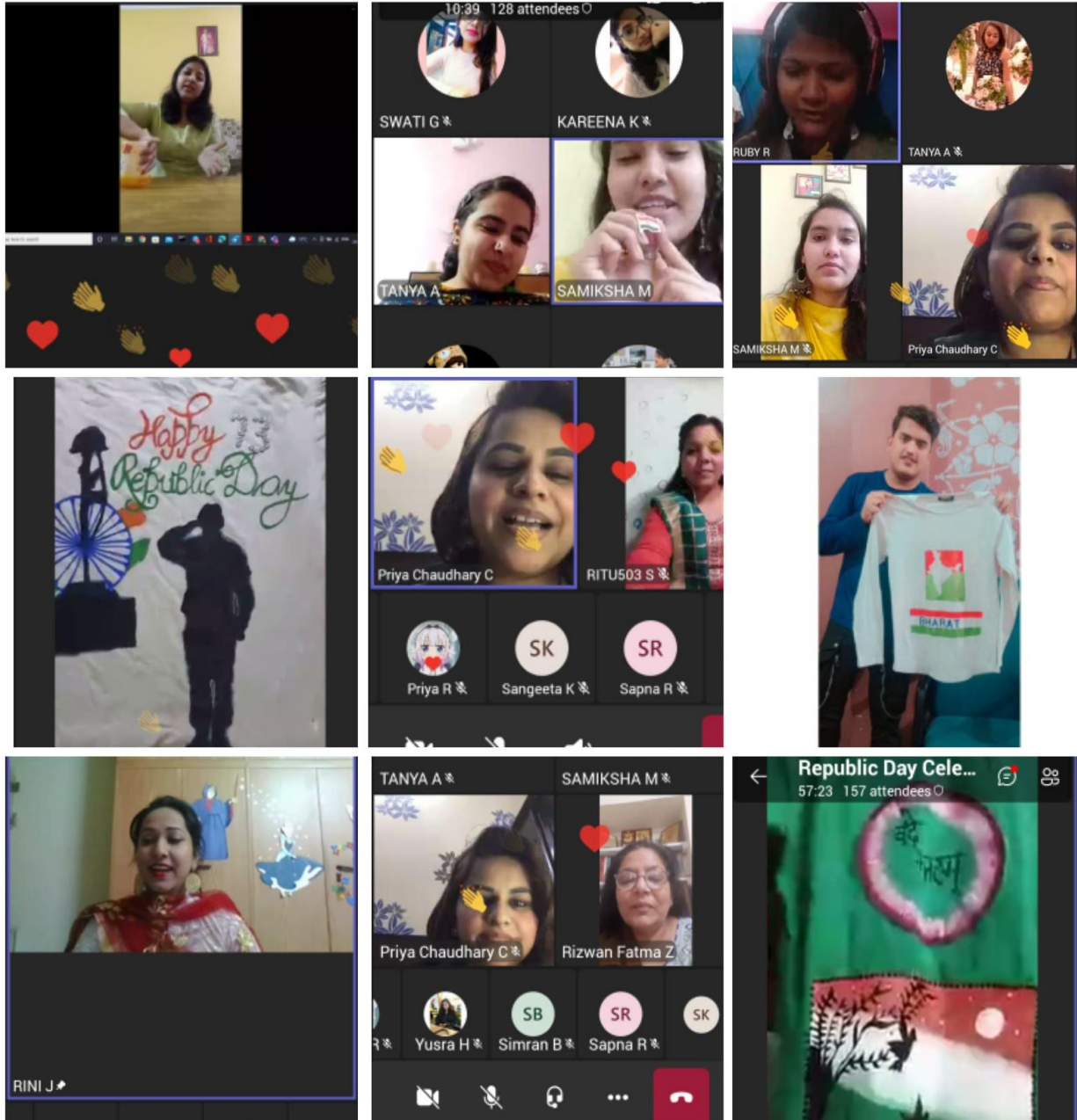
Theme - Patriotic Songs

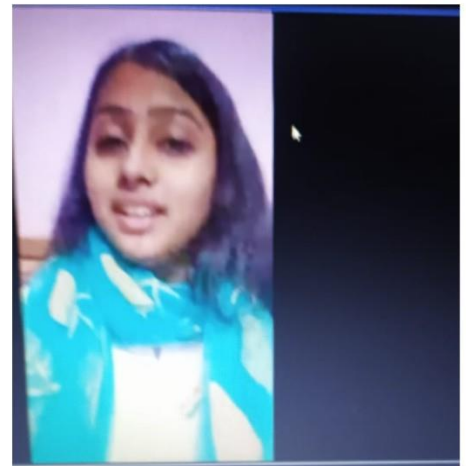
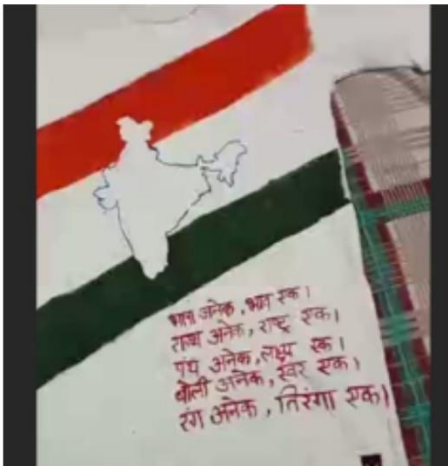
1. Participants can sing the patriotic song either in Hindi/ English.
