ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Institute of Vocational Studies, 71/86, Zakir Nager New Friends colony, New Delhi - 110025 had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council For Teacher Education for grant of recognition for starting **B.Ed. of One Year** from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred)** Students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution the documents attached there with and the input received from the visiting team, the Regional committee in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, granted recognition to **Institute of Vocational Studies, 71/86, Zakir Nager, New Friends Colony, New Delhi - 1210025** for **B.Ed. of One year** from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred)** students to fulfillment of the following:-

- (a) That the institution will ensure that Principal / Head and at least Seven faculty members are in position for an intake of 100 Students before commencement of the course and a report to the effect duly verified by the Registrar of the concerned University shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- (b) The institution shall, within one months of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition.
- (d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

3. The institution has now shifted over to its permanent premises at Awadh Bhawan Fc-3I Sheik Sarai Institutional Area. Phase-II New Delhi and applied for permission to shift over the permanent Premises vide letters dt. 11.3.2003.

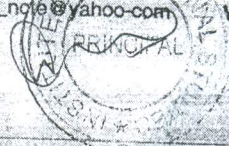

The Regional Committee after careful Consideration of the file, Visiting team report and other relevant documents in its 62<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> April 2003 decided to grant recognition to the institute for conducting B.Ed. Course with annual intake of 100 students at the new premise with the address Awadh Bhawan Fc-31 Sheik Sarai Institutional Area. Phase-II New Delhi.

1. The Recognition is subject to the condition, that over its new permanent premises, the affiliating university shall ensure that, among other things, the institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal / Head of Department), as per the norms of the NCTE/UGC/Affiliating University.

2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of the conditions as stipulated vide above referred to Order for the year 2002-3 as mentioned in para-2 above (excepted) and all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc from time to time.

3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university/State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual income and expenditure duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

4. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
